





ABOUT THE AUTHOR

RAQUEL RIBA ROSSY

(Igualada, 1990) has been very sure about her goals since she was a child: she wanted to convey messages through her characters and stories. Daughter of the architect Jaume Riba and the multidisciplinary artist Clara Rossy, she was nourished by the creative environment that exuded from a family of painters, illustrators, architects and musicians. From an early age she drew without counting the hours and sang as if she was living in a musical, without thinking about the decibels. She studied Fine Arts at the Universitat of Barcelona and illustration at the Escola de la Dona de Barcelona. In 2017 she stormed the bookstores with Lola Vendetta, main character of her books **Más vale Lola que mal acompañada** (Better Be a Lola Than in Bad Company), ¿Qué pacha, mama? (Whassup, Mommy?, 2018), Lola Vendetta y los hombres (Lola Vendetta and the Men, 2019) y Una habitación propia con Wifi (Your Own Room With a Wifi, 2021).

In 2022, she publishes **Morder la manzana** (Bite the Apple) with Planeta Cómic, adapting **Leticia Dolera**'s work to graphic novel, of which she already made a fragment in **Voces que cuentan** (Voices That Count), anthology published in 2021 also with Planeta Cómic.

In 2023 she returns to Lola Vendetta with **Katanazo al amor romántico** (Katana Spanking to Romantic Love), the first part of the most defining story of her character.

Through illustration she has learned to know herself and to connect with many women around the world. In 2021 she released her first music album "El Primer Canto" with which she launched into the world of music with 10 songs of her own making and also creating all the graphic design that accompanied it. Thus achieving a conjunction of her two favourite languages: music and illustration.






No me cuentes cuentos

SUMMARY

Snow White threw herself into the arms of a love that she thought was perfect and that ended up cancelling her; Sleeping Beauty fell into a forced sleep and, when she woke up, she had suffered a rape; Ariel had a part of her body torn off under the pretext of achieving purity; Little Red Riding Hood went to the San Fermín festivities and was raped by five wolves, the Pamplona Pack. All of them are real testimonies.

Sandra Sabatés has interviewed women who live next to us, young people who deal with their ghosts while trying to rebuild their lives... They are also survivors, like the protagonists of classic stories, although the stories collected here are hardly childish. The rawness of a reality that refuses to disappear remains, but also the hope that the day will come when monsters only live in fiction.

CARLES ESQUEMBRE

is a comic author, illustrator and musician born in Valencia, who works and lives in a village of Alicante. He studied Graphic Art at Escola Joso in Barcelona. He has worked as a concept and storyboard artist and freelance illustrator for Dacsa Produccions, Tigre de Paper, Videomapping Pro, Taules Teatre, Timelapse Creative Agency and Rumores Factory, among others.

He self-published his first comic in 2013, **The Body**, a pulp science fiction comic where tiny paramedics are introduced inside a sick human body. In 2016 he published **Lorca** - **Un poeta en Nueva York** (Lorca - A Poet in New York, Panini Comics). In 2018 publishes **La Brigada Lincoln**

(The Lincoln Brigade, Panini Comics) where he was in charge of the drawing, with script by **Pablo Durá** and colors by **Ester Salguero**, recently published in the United States by Caliber Comics.

His work has also been included in several anthologies, such as **Visiones del fin** (Visions of the End, Aleta; 2015) y **Diferente: 140 artistas. Una única historia** (Different: 140 artists. A Single Story, Planeta Cómic; 2019).

Las tres heridas de Miguel Hernández (The Three Wounds of Miguel Hernández) is his first full-length work with Planeta Cómic.

His most recent work has been in the North American market, where he has been in charge of conceptualizing and coloring, along with illustrator **José María Beroy**, the official comic book adaptation of Andrew Lloyd Webber's musical **The Phantom of the Opera** (Titan Comics; 2020).

He is currently working as colorist on the comic of the rock band Mötley Crüe: **The Dirt Declassified**, with a script of Leah Moore (Z2 Comics).

His style, realistic and pop, has led him to be awarded several times in the SMA (Silent Manga Audition; Coamix Inc./North Stars Pictures) of Japan.

In 2020, with the Valencian writer **Sergio Hernández**, he begins to publish the manga **Backhome** in **Planeta Manga**, a fast-paced thriller that evokes Oku Hiroya's or Kengo Hanazawa's

style. Only a year later, both received the Diafebús Juvenile Novel Award for their work **El Diari de Laia** (Laia's Diary). Another of his striking works is **Reflejos del futuro** (Reflections of the Future; 2022), with **Blanca Mira** and published by **Planeta Manga**. In 2022, **Backhome** saw the light in volume format and with it a new stage in his career began.



SERGIO HERNÁNDEZ

(Valencia, 1994), writer and screenwriter, is a Hispanic philologist from the Universitat de València and writer graduated from the Centro Sperimentale di Cinematografia in Rome and Barreira A+D. In 2015, year in which he began to write several radio programs, he published **365 primeras citas** (365 first dates, Alupa Editorial). Months later he made the leap to the audiovisual, adapting his work to the short film format for RTVE. In 2019 he published **La última canción de primavera** (Spring's Last Song, OléLibros), achieving a fantastic reception from critics and filmmakers such as Isabel Coixet.

After years dedicated to the world of communication and advertising, he founded Collverd, the first creative generator of fiction content in Spain, developing series and feature films for production companies and platforms in Spain and Latin America. He combines




