
SPRING FLOWER




In spring the sun is shining again, the days are longer, and we all want to spend time outdoors. The forest blooms once more, and the animals give birth to their young. We eat peas, asparagus, strawberries, and cherries. We enjoy nature: we gaze at the insects, plant seeds, and have picnics...







- The passing of time and the seasons are key themes taught in preschool that help children understand nature's cycles. The books are in tune with Waldorf and Montessori pedagogies and are perfect to place on seasonal tables either at home or in school.
- As they deal with topics that do not age, they are likely to become long sellers as they are relaunched with each season.
- The content is related to children's day-to-day life: the weather, how we dress, the activities we do, the fruits and vegetables we eat in each season, and what goes on in the forest at different times of the year.





SUMMER SUN

In summer, the sun beams down on us. The days are long and hot. There is lots going in the forest and the fruit ripens on the trees. We eat tomatoes, watermelon, melon, cherries, and peaches. We go on holiday, play on the beach and by the river... and of course we eat ice cream to cool us down.

Autumn brings rain and wind. We get out our raincoats, wellington boots, and umbrellas! Leaves fall from the trees, and when we step on them, they crunch, crunch! The forests transform into different colours. Mushrooms and snails come out, and the animals begin to prepare for the cold. We eat grapes, pumpkins, mushrooms, figs, pomegranates, persimmons, and chestnuts. We play in the forest and collect pinecones, acorns, conkers, and red and orange leaves. We decorate our houses with dry leaves, we roast sweet potatoes, and read stories.
